

The Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) Team

The IFSP team must include:

Parent or Parents (and other family members—with prior written notice)

A Service Coordinator (they create the IFSP and help to make sure things go forward)

Evaluation Personnel (those who have conducted evaluations or assessments identifying needs)

Early Intervention (EI) (those who will provide EI services for the child or family)



The IFSP team might also include specialists such as a:

Doctor or Medical Specialist

Therapist

Child Development Specialist
