Pathfinder Services of ND (PSND) is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization helping families, youth, and professionals through:

- Training and resources for education, special needs rights, and self-advocacy
- Support and advocacy for housing, safety, and basic needs
- Assisting families facing homelessness with family shelter and affordable housing

Parent Training & Information Center (PTI)

North Dakota's federally funded PTI center supports families of children with disabilities (birth–26):

- Understand special education rights
- Access services and resources
- Participate in IEPs and school decisions
- Support youth in self-advocacy

Continuum of Care Program (COC)

Helping rural youth ages 14–24 at risk of or experiencing homelessness:

- One-on-one and peer-led support
- Create Plans of Action (POAs) focused on housing, safety, school, work, and health
- Quick connections to shelters, food, employment, and health providers

PSND Broadway Circle (PBC)

PBC prevents family separation and provides transitional housing and support toward permanent housing:

- PBC Family Homeless Shelter: 6 two and three-bedroom family units
- PBC LMI Complex: 17 efficiency, one, and two-bedroom units for Low to Moderate Income (LMI) qualifiers
- Support Services: assure families receive the resources and services they need to successfully shift into long-term permanent housing.



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
