This is your chance to introduce yourself and those who make up your IEP team.

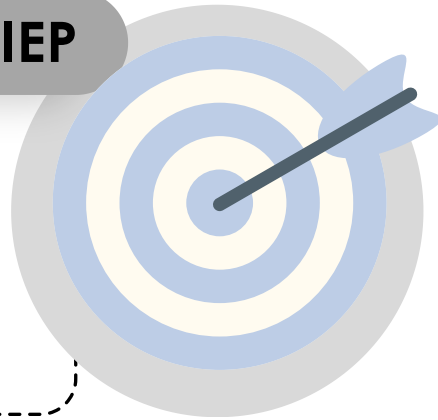
PURPOSE OF YOUR MEETING:

Is this your "Annual Review" for your IEP or is the meeting being held to discuss a special purpose? Share with the group why you are meeting and what the goal is for your meeting.

REVIEW & UPDATES TO THE IEP

REVIEW CURRENT GOALS & OUTCOMES:

You can share your current goals and outcomes. Remember your goals are written in your IEP and you should have been working on them throughout the year.

REVIEW MY PROGRESS:

- This may be a good time to turn the time over to your special education case manager.
- The responsible person will be able to share updated data and testing results if applicable.
- This is a time to discuss how things are going towards meeting your goals.

MY STRENGTHS & INTERESTS:

- Take some time before your meeting to think about this. What are your strengths and interest?
- You are amazing and have many strengths so be sure to share those with your team

MY AREAS OF NEEDS TO BE SUCCESSFUL IN SCHOOL:

What do you feel will help you be successful in school?

MY GOALS FOR LIFE AFTER GRADUATION:

What would you like to do after graduation? Do you want to go to work? Would you like to attend college or a trade school? Would you like to focus on volunteer work?

WHAT SUPPORTS DO I CURRENTLY HAVE:

- What supports do you currently have and are those still working? If not, what do you feel like would be more helpful?
- Are your current supports working?

CLOSING YOUR MEETING

REVIEW THE MEETING & CHANGES MADE TODAY:

- This is the time to do a quick recap of what was discussed.
- You could ask your special education case manager to do this part.
