The North Dakota Federation of Families for Children's Mental Health is a state and national family-run organization focused on the issues of children and youth with emotional, behavioral, or mental health needs and their families. It was conceived in Bismarck, North Dakota in May 4, 1994 by a group of 6 families determined to make a difference in the way the system works. ND Federation of Families is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.

Members of the ND Federation of Families come from all walks of life. Emotional, behavioral or mental health needs cut across all income, educational, geographical, racial, ethnic, and religious groups. They are found among single parents and two-parent families and in birth, adoptive, and foster families.

The ND Federation of Families works to develop and implement policies, legislation, funding mechanisms, and service systems that utilize the strengths of families. Its emphasis on advocacy offers families a voice in the formation of state and national policy, services and supports for children with mental health needs and their families.

Vision Statement

Through a family and youth-driven approach, children and youth with emotional, behavioral, and mental health challenges and their families obtain needed supports and services so that children grow up healthy and able to maximize their potential.
